



Farmington Hills Nature Center

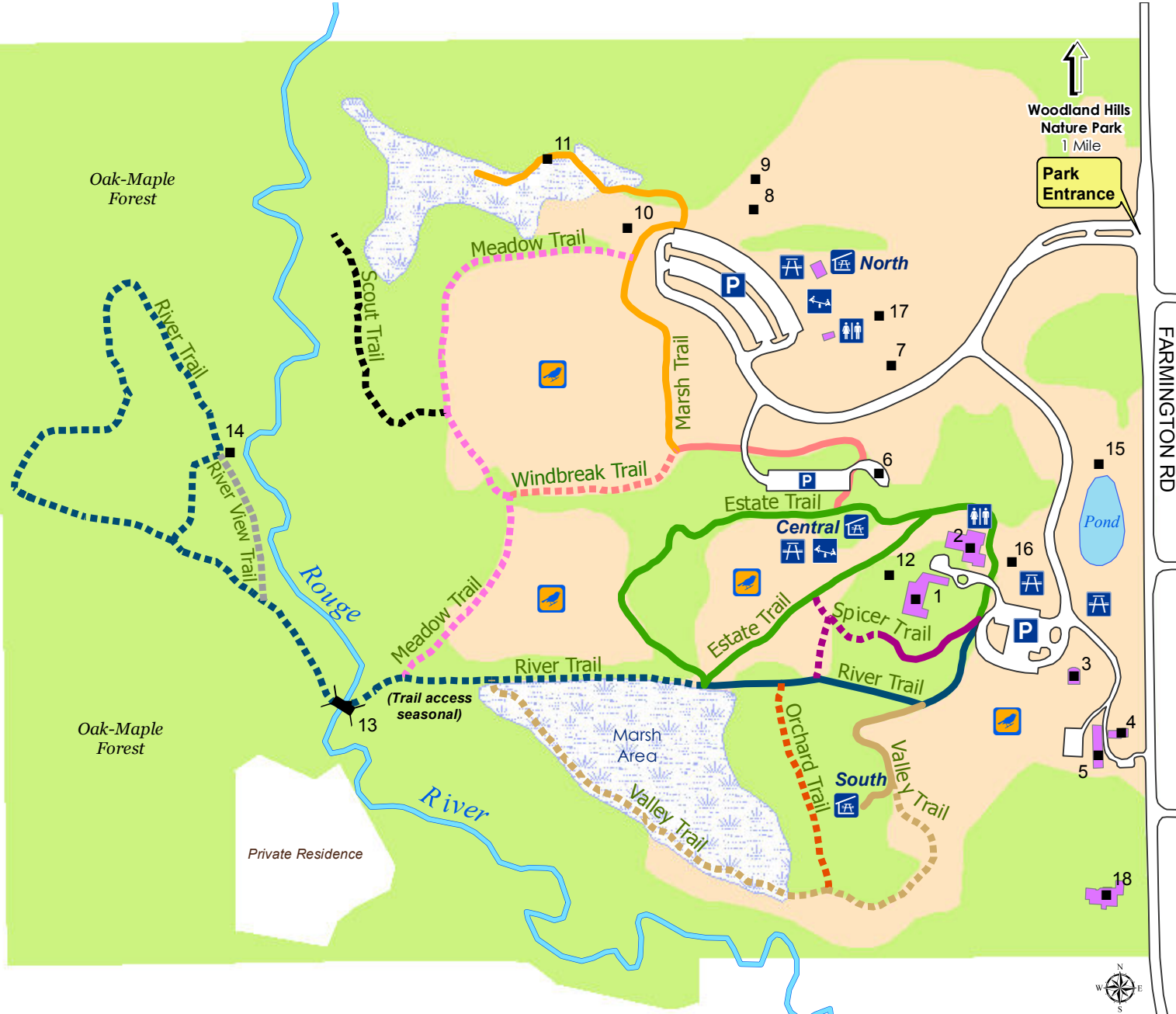

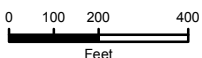
