## City of Farmington Hills Now Offers Text Notifications

The City of Farmington Hills is now offering a new Text Notification System to inform residents about emergencies and other happenings in and around the City. Messages will have a 160-character maximum and will feature a tagline showing that they were officially sent from the City of Farmington Hills.

The new service will reach subscribers quickly and reliably with messages sent via their text-enabled mobile devices. Up-to-the-minute information will be sent out about topics such as road closures, police situations, boil water alerts, and more. An additional service, with a separate subscriber list, will offer text messages about Parks and Recreation cancellation notices.

Farmington Hills residents and other interested users can self-register via the City's website. To sign up for the Text Notification System, simply go to [www.fhgov.com](http://www.fhgov.com), click on Quick Links, then Text Notification System, then click on the list that you'd like to join and follow instructions to subscribe.

The City's Text Notification System was developed in cooperation with Muniweb, the company that manages the Farmington Hills website. Unlike text messaging systems used by other cities, there is no fee for the City to administer the service. There is no charge to subscribe, but standard text messaging rates will apply for any notices sent to mobile devices.
